Scramble Format - 9 holes
Tee times 10:30-11:50

Please arrive by 10 AM or shortly thereafter for cart prep, a beverage, reading of the rules and encouragement as 8 teams! tee off. Although we are at 10 minute intervals between foursomes, each team will tee off once the team ahead of them has hit their second shots. We want to expedite this so that it doesn't interfere with our afternoon nap times.

The Rules

A scramble format has members of a team competing against all other teams in the field. Each golfer hits their own ball and the best ball hit by the group will determine the location where everyone will hit from next until holing out. The team score is the only score to record.

Women will tee off from the gray/forward tees, and men from the light blue tees immediately behind them.

- Each team must play from at least one drive from each player, except when there is a health limitation for a player.
- In groups of three players each player will take a rotation turn playing the fourth shot.
- There will be flag events on some holes and those awards will be for individuals.
- In the event a ball is hit into the woods or otherwise cannot be found we want to impose the new (Rule 18.2) PGA limit for searching for a ball to a maximum of three minutes. If you've had that ball in your bag since we graduated, give it up!
- No mulligans or gimmes, although Reunion Committee Member Michael Sajbel directed the film "The Mulligan" which comes out in all digital media August 16. A shameless plug!

Turn in your scorecard to Phil Berg when finishing your round. Then feel free to get a fermented beverage and cheer on the other teams until the final foursome comes in. Or ridiculously heckle them.

More Rules

The Golf Event organizers and the Reunion Committee will be the sole judges of tie breakers and prizes which will be announced at the Saturday night event. If none of the players from a winning foursome are at the Saturday evening event, they do not have to be present to win.
